

30-MINUTE FIRE EVACUATION

1. VALUABLES

- a. emergency go bags
- b. cell phone, FRS and ham radios & their chargers
- c. ID & money
- d. computer backup / laptop
- e. important documents, family photos, irreplaceable items

POST FIRE: change outgoing voicemail message so family & friends know where to reach you

2. PETS

- a. cat in carrier / dog in car w/ collar & leash and their emergency go bags

3. TO DO:

- a. bring fire clothes (cotton clothes, leather gloves, goggles, solid shoes, breathing mask, head covering, headlamp)
- b. close all windows and interior and exterior doors
- c. open all curtains and blinds
- d. move furniture away from windows
- e. move deck items (including welcome mats) away from house
- f. turn on all house lights
- g. place extension ladders in front of house
- h. turn off propane tank

4. EVACUATE “BUDDY” NEIGHBORS’ KIDS AND ANIMALS

5. FOLLOW EVACUATION INSTRUCTIONS FROM AUTHORITIES

IF CAN'T LEAVE THE CANYON: LIST YOUR PLAN B, C, D (stay home, go to CSA, NSA, etc.)
